

HUI PAOKALANI NEW PADDLER INFORMATION

HUI PAOKALANI Welcomes ALL New Paddlers. This information is provided to help you as you make the decision to join our club.

- **FIRST PADDLE FREE** – Hui Paoakalani Members pay membership dues each year. These dues help with the cost of the Hui’s Insurance, GSL Marina Expenses, Hui “Shack” Rental, Maintaining our Wa’a, Trailer, and Paddles. **Hui Paoakalani Managers, Board Members and Coaches DO NOT GET PAID.** They share their knowledge and time because they love the Hui, the Hawaiian Culture and they love the sport of Outrigger Canoe Paddling. Therefore, we offer a “FIRST PADDLE FREE” policy. After your first paddle with our club, you will need to make a decision to purchase a 2010 Season Membership or you may pay the \$10.00 per day Drop In “DAY RATE.”
- **MEMBERSHIP FORMS AND FEES-** All 2010 Membership Forms are available on-line. To view FEES please refer our Membership form located on our blog at www.huipaoakalani.blogspot.com .
- **REQUIRED FORMS-** ALL Paddlers will be required to sign a **Hui Paoakalani Waiver form** before paddling. Please download, complete, sign and bring the form with you. If you decide to join the Hui, You will also need to complete and sign the **Hui Paoakalani Membership Form**. Again ALL forms are located on the blog.
- **COLLEGE STUDENT MEMBERSHIP RATE-** Please contact Darren at hui_paoakalani@live.com for rates and information. Proof of registration will be required.
- **DROP IN OR “DAY RATES”-** Hui Paoakalani’s DROP IN RATE is \$10.00 per day. Checks can be made out to KLMF (Ka Lama Mohala Foundation) or you can pay cash and we will provide you with a receipt.
- **SET UP AND CLEAN UP** – As Hui Members, we ALL work together to have fun and maintain our Wa’a and other equipment. It is expected if you show up to paddle, you will help with the set up and clean up of our wa’a and equipment. We realize that sometimes schedules don’t allow you to always be there when we are setting up or cleaning up; however YOU ARE EXPECTED to help when you can. This is part of our 2010 Mandatory Service Hours for your discounted membership.

- **CLUB EQUIPMENT-** You may use our Hui paddles and other equipment while you are paddling with our Hui. You may be asked to sign in before using a Hui paddle. **YOU are ALWAYS responsible for the HUI PADDLE you are using.** Paddles and other equipment cost money and we would like to ensure that they are treated with respect. **DO NOT** throw them down or use them as Walking Sticks. When you are done using a paddle, please **rinse the paddle with clean water and return it to the Hui Shack. Failure to comply with may result with you being required to replace damaged equipment.**
- **WORKOUT AND SERVICE LOGS-** Please sign our Workout log before paddling for the day. Also log in your service hours for the season. These will be located in the Hui Shack.
- **HUI POT LUCKS-**It is customary for the Hui to have Potlucks after our paddles. This happens regularly after our Saturday paddles. Please plan on bringing something to share...if you DO NOT want to bring something, you can make a monetary donation to our “Donation Jar” which is located in the Hui Shack. These monetary donations are used to help pay for paper products, trash bags, and shack cleaning supplies.
