LEI ALOHA O KA `OHANA Family, the Never Ending Circle of Aloha



Lei Aloha O Ka `Ohana - Family, the Never Ending Circle of Aloha (LAOKO) has been funded by the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) to develop a healthy relationships curriculum based on traditional Hawaiian values and the *`Ohana* (family) concept.

This program offers culturally based lessons and activities promoting family unity, teaching problem solving skills, and strengthening family cohesiveness. It is designed to teach Native Hawaiian values and concepts that are consistent with your own values and beliefs. Workshops are created to be taught in the style of an open forum for discussion with hands-on activities intertwined into each lesson.

Kalo (Taro) was not only the staple food of Hawaii but also strongly bound to Hawaiian culture and belief. The origin of *Kalo* is *Hāloa*, the son of *Wākea*, first man and ancestor of all Hawaiians. The Hawaiian word for family is *`Ohana*, derived from the words *`Oha* (taro corm growing from the older root) and *Na* (many). The root word *`Oha* is indicative of the centrality of family in Hawaiian culture. Members of an *`ohana*, “like taro corms, are all from the same root.”
